John Cannon and Will McCurry combined for 21 points in the fourth quarter to lead a dramatic 70-59 comeback victory against Mitchell Thursday night in the second round of the Western Highlands Conference Tournament. The Cougars, who built as much as a 15 point lead in the second quarter, could not put the scrappy Mountaineers away, in part due to foul problems and ended up being assessed 14 fouls in the first half. Mitchell used those trips to the free throw line along with timely shooting to close the Cougar lead at halftime to five points. The Mountaineers used that momentum to streak to as much as a seven point lead in the third quarter before Cannon and McCurry led the Cougars comeback. Cannon, who ended with 20 points, had been stymied most of the night before connecting for 14 in the final frame. He also added 11 rebounds and four blocks, but his presence altered many Mountaineer shots in the game. Steven Wilson added 13 for Mountain Heritage along with 12 rebounds and five steals. Michael Fender also added 12 points and five steals and did an excellent job running the floor and protecting the ball. Mountain Heritage plays Madison in the WHC championship game Friday night. The victory raised their season record to 19-6.
