Steven Wilson scored 22 of his game high 26 points in the second half as Mountain Heritage overcame a sluggish start to beat Hendersonville Friday night 78-66. Wilson, who hit all eight of his field goal attempts in the second half, including both three pointers attempted, also added six rebounds for the Cougars. Mountain Heritage started slowly, turning the ball over 10 times in the first quarter and trailed by as much as 10 points in the second period. The Cougars closed the first half with an 11-0 run to take a 31-30 at halftime, their first lead of the game. The Cougars were unable to shake the scrappy and quick Bearcats team until the fourth quarter. Mountain Heritage once again got a total team effort, with Dylan McMahan, Michael Fender and John Cannon all reaching double figures in scoring in addition to Wilson. Cannon also added 12 rebounds and 10 blocks and McMahan and Fender did an excellent job of controlling tempo and minimizing turnovers. The Cougars upped their conference record to 5-1 and their overall record to 11-5. Tuesday night they return home to play Owen High School.
