The Madison Patriots captured the regular season Western Highlands Conference by defeating Mountain Heritage 70-64 at Madison High School Friday night. The victory also gave the Patriots top seed in next week's conference tournament and avenged their only conference loss of the season. The Cougars suffered most of the game with poor shooting making only 13 of 43 shots through the first three quarters. In the fourth quarter, the Cougars found their stroke, connecting on six three-pointers and erasing a seven point deficit on the strength of their shooting. However, since the Cougars had been foul prone all night, Madison made numerous trips to the free throw line connecting them and beating back every Mountain Heritage charge, finally outlasting the scrappy Cougars. By the end of the game, the fact that the Cougars were tagged with 31 team fouls whereas Madison was tagged with 18, proved be the difference in a game where there were few turnovers considering the pace. Will McCurry led the Cougars with 19 points and led the fourth quarter charge. Steven Wilson added 13 and John Cannon contributed 10 points. The Cougars ended their regular season in second place in the conference with a 10-2 record and were 17-6 overall.
