Mountain Heritage outlasted a scrappy Avery team Wednesday night and pulled away in the final minutes for a 71-63 victory. The Cougars started strong and held a working lead in the first half but when Dustin Clarke connected on a last second three point shot, the Vikings only trailed by one at the intermission. The second half was close, and the lead exchanged hands on several occasions, and neither team could pull away. Every time that it seemed Avery might increase their lead, the Cougars got a key basket from either John Cannon or Steven Wilson. Cannon and Wilson, who lead the Cougars with 28 and 23 points respectively, were especially tough in the fourth quarter, and accounted for most of the Heritage scoring in the second half. Clark led Avery with 22 (including 16 in the first half) and recorded a number of outstanding assists in the second half that provided his teammates with scoring opportunities. The Cougars upped their conference record to 3-0 and their overall record to 6-1. They return to action Friday with a trip to Madison.
