They were able to overcome these errors by connecting on 62.5% of their field goals and making 88.5% of their free throws. John Cannon led the Cougars with 18 points and recorded numerous blocks and rebounds on the defensive end. He also shot a perfect 6-6 from the charity stripe. Steven Wilson, after a slow start on the offensive side, was second on the team with 14 points and made all six of his free throws in the fourth quarter. Mitchell made several runs in the fourth quarter but each time the Cougars had an answer or would make key free throws to maintain their working margin. Mountain Heritage returns to action on Tuesday as they travel to Avery High School. The win also upped their season record to 5-1.
