John Cannon led the Cougars with 23 points, including 14 in the second half. Steven Wilson added 21. Both Cannon and Wilson had 10 rebounds. Alex Biggerstaff added 14 points in the win. Matthew Kardulis dished off 12 assists as well, but in the end everyone contributed in a total team win. The Cougars improved their record to 6-0 in conference and 9-1 overall. Thursday, the Cougars travel to play Christ School, who have been ranked in the top ten in the entire country this year in what promises to be a challenging game for Heritage.
