Mountain Heritage, making up an earlier date, lost to a powerful Christ School Thursday night 90-56. The Greenies upped their record to 23-1 combining deadly three point shooting with an aggressive half court trapping defense. Christ School connected on six three pointers in the first half and nine in the second half en route to their victory. They were led by University of South Carolina prospect Eric Smith who led all scorers with 26 points, who connected on five three pointers. In addition two of their other starters have already committed to Elon University for next year. A total of eight of the players on their roster were at least 6' 4" and the combination of these players and their skills have led Christ School to be nationally ranked in the top 20 high school basketball teams in the country. The Cougars, to their credit, never quit and although the press did give them some problems, for the most part they stayed composed. In addition, John Cannon, who led the Cougars with 15 points, held his own against the Greenies big men. Steven Wilson was second in scoring with 12. The entire team is to be commended for their effort and several fans of Christ School told Heritage spectators that the Cougars had played as well as anyone this season against the Greenies. The game was also a good test of playing in front of a loud hostile crowd, and again Heritage responded well. The Cougars return (9-2 and 6-0) return to conference play Friday when they host Polk.
