Mountain Heritage defeated Polk for the second time this week 76-55 at home Friday night. After a quick start by the Cougars, the Wolverines stayed close most of the first half, although Heritage made 7 of 8 three pointers in the second quarter after making only one of their first 11 three point attempts in the first quarter. In spite of the three point shooting, Polk was only down 11 at the half, well within striking distance. The Cougars broke the game open in the third quarter behind the shooting of John Cannon. Cannon ended the game as the high scorer with 19 points, followed closely by Steven Wilson and Alex Biggerstaff who had 18 each. Wilson and Biggerstaff were responsible for the second quarter three pointer blitz, connecting on four and three respectively in that frame without a miss. The Cougars, to their credit, did not come out flat after their challenging game at Christ School the night before. Heritage (10-2, 7-0) resumes its conference schedule Tuesday at Owen High School. The War Horses are the last conference team that the Cougars have not played this year.
